• Events, Facilities & Kitchen Use

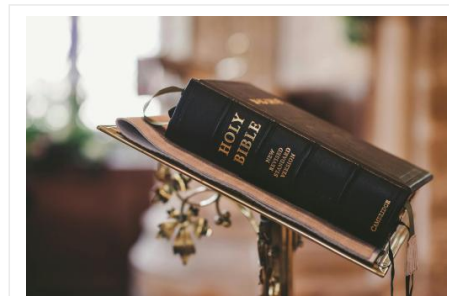
How to request rooms, food safety basics, cleanup standards, and insurance notes.
