Record setpoint and actual temps at handoff; log genset fuel levels. Why this matters: “Reefer Power and Temperature Checks” codifies shared expectations so members reduce risk, respect partners and customers, and move...

• Gate Congestion Playbook

Meter inbound volumes and extend night gates during surges; communicate via SMS and load boards. Why this matters: “Gate Congestion Playbook” codifies shared expectations so members reduce risk, respect partners and...



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
