At least one certified handler on shift; thermometer logs kept. Why this matters: "Staff Food Safety Training" codifies shared expectations so members reduce risk, respect partners and customers, and move faster...

• POS, Taxes, and Reconciliation

Keep backups for POS; remit taxes timely; provide sales summaries to hosts. Why this matters: "POS, Taxes, and Reconciliation" codifies shared expectations so members reduce risk, respect partners and customers, and...

• Rain and Severe Weather Plan

Tents weighted; wind thresholds posted; menu adjusted for rain. Why this matters: "Rain and Severe Weather Plan" codifies shared expectations so members reduce risk, respect partners and customers, and move faster...

• Shared Power/Water Hookups

Coordinate draw; avoid tripping circuits; bring adapters. Why this matters: "Shared Power/Water Hookups" codifies shared expectations so members reduce risk, respect partners and customers, and move faster together...
