Follow FMCSA standards; straps and chains inspected. Why this matters: "Cargo Securement" codifies shared expectations so members reduce risk, respect partners and customers, and move faster together without cutting...

• Broker/Carrier Communication

24/7 contact for live loads; respectful tone; document changes. Why this matters: "Broker/Carrier Communication" codifies shared expectations so members reduce risk, respect partners and customers, and move faster...
