• Prizes and Eligibility

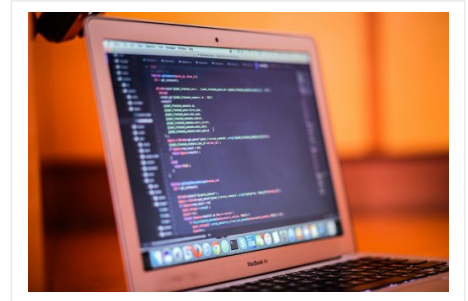
