
Squid Game rules

The Squid Game, as depicted in the Netflix series, is a deadly competition based on Korean children's games. The core rules, as explained in the show, involve dividing players into two teams, offense and defense, with the goal for the offense to reach a designated area within a squid-shaped court. Defenders try to eliminate attackers by pushing them out of bounds or preventing their progress. Violence is allowed, and players who violate rules or lose are eliminated (killed in the show)

Sample Rules / Principles

• Squid Game

Players are divided into two teams: attackers and defenders. Attackers aim to reach the squid's head in the court's center, while defenders prevent them. The attacker who reaches the head and taps it wins; players may...

• Glass Bridge

Players must cross a bridge made of glass panels, some tempered (safe) and some regular (breakable). Each player chooses one panel per step, and stepping on a regular panel causes it to break, leading to elimination....

• Marbles

Players are paired and given ten marbles each. They must compete in a marble game of their choice against their partner within 30 minutes. The player who wins all their partner's marbles advances; the loser is...

• Tug-of-War

Players are divided into teams. Each team pulls on opposite ends of a rope, attempting to drag the opposing team across a central line or off a raised platform. The winning team advances; the losing team is eliminated.
