This park is home to the top-notch Bobby Bailey Tennis Center, the ADA-accessible Field of Dreams ballfield, and the exceptional ALTA-approved pickleball courts. Whether you're a tennis enthusiast, a pickleball player, or someone looking for an accessible and family-friendly recreational area, Alberta Banks Park caters to all. Enjoy a day filled with activity and fun at this well-equipped local park.

Facilities:

- 12 Lighted Tennis Courts - 9 Lighted Pickleball Courts - 3 Baseball/Softball Fields
- 1 Rubberized ADA Field & Playground - Pavilion (max 70; grill/electricity/water)
- Playground - Restrooms - Parking - Water - Grill

Pets: Leashed pets allowed in park, not on ball fields.

Sample Rules / Principles

• Pickleball Court Rules and Regulations

- Observe paddle stacking etiquette and rotate fairly.
- No food/drinks on courts (water in closed containers OK).
- Non-marking shoes required.
- Be courteous with ball retrieval and line calls.
- No pets on pickleball...

• Facilities Hours & Reservations

General Hours: 7:00 a.m. 10:00 p.m. daily. Lights: Courts available until 10:00 p.m. (see Lights Instructions rule). Fields: Practice and games require reservations; priority to youth leagues during season. Pavilion:...

• Pickleball Court Lights: Instructions for Use

- Activation: Press the push button on the left rear pole of the shelter facing the courts. Available 30 minutes before sunset.
- Duration: 2 hours per press.
- Extend: Press again for another 2 hours (before 10 p.m.)....

• Pavilion Reservation

Reserve online before use. Pavilion is outdoor covered (not enclosed), max occupancy 70; grill, electricity, and water available. Respect time slots and clean up after events.
