- Pets on leash; not in swim areas or buildings
- Fires in provided rings only; fully extinguish before leaving or sleeping
- Reservations required for campsites and shelters; follow posted limits

Sample Rules / Principles

• Generator Use

Generators may be used except during Quiet Hours (10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.). Position to reduce noise and exhaust for neighbors.

• Trash, Wildlife, and Food Storage

Store food securely and do not feed wildlife. Dispose of trash promptly in proper containers to avoid animals and pests.

• Swim and Shoreline Safety

Swim at your own risk. No lifeguards are on duty. Stay off restricted shoreline and structures. Children require close supervision.

• Vehicles, Parking, and Boat Trailers

Follow the posted maximum vehicles per site. Park only on pads or approved surfaces. Boat trailers must use designated areas.
