• Open Permits and Inspections Tracker

Create a real-time permits and inspections tracker with open APIs so residents, contractors, and journalists can follow applications from intake to sign-off. The system will show queue positions, average review times by...

• Homes Near Transit Zoning Reform

Modernize zoning in ½-mile walksheds of high-frequency transit to allow small apartments, missing-middle housing, and mixed-use corner stores. Inclusionary requirements will ensure a portion of new units are affordable...

• Vision Zero High-Injury Network Fixes

Within 24 months, deliver design fixes on 80% of the High-Injury Network: raised crosswalks, daylighted corners, hardened centerlines, protected bike intersections, and leading pedestrian intervals. Site selection is...

• Lead Service Line Replacement Accelerator

Replace all known lead service lines within eight years, starting with childcare centers, schools, and census blocks with the highest blood lead risk. The city will offer 0% interest homeowner side replacements...



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
