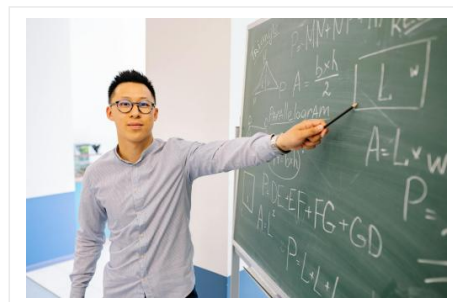

Jordan Nguyen - Brookside Schools 2026

Sample Rules / Principles

• Safe, Welcoming, and Well-Maintained Schools

Create campus safety audits (lighting, sightlines, controlled access), expand restorative practices, and deploy facility work-order SLAs (e.g., priority repairs within 72 hours). Monthly public reports show response...

• Arts, Music, and After-School Enrichment

Guarantee access to visual/performing arts at every campus; fund instruments and materials; and run after-school enrichment 3 days/week (arts/STEM/homework help). Attendance and satisfaction surveys guide scheduling....

• CTE & Dual Credit Pathways

Expand Career and Technical Education pathways (health, IT, advanced manufacturing) aligned with regional employers. Offer dual-credit courses with local colleges and paid internships for 11th–12th graders. Report...

• Teacher Hiring, Mentoring, and Retention

Create an early-offer pipeline with residency stipends, reduced first-year load, and mentor teacher pay. Add observation cycles with bite-size feedback and PLC time guarded on the master schedule. Track retention by...
