About this Community

Clearwater County Safe & Fair 2026 is the public forum for sheriff candidate Alex Monroe's plan to deliver constitutional, community-centered policing. The platform focuses on reducing harm, improving response times, and building trust through transparency.

Alex Monroe is a 20-year law enforcement veteran who has led patrol, investigations, and training. Alex's priorities include modern dispatch and data systems, co-responder teams for behavioral health, jail reentry that lowers repeat offenses, and independent oversight with public dashboards. On RuleTogether, Alex posts proposals, invites feedback, and reports progress toward safer neighborhoods and fair treatment for all.

Sample Rules / Principles

- **Independent Oversight & Complaint Portal**

Stand up an independent civilian review panel with subpoena authority per law. Launch an online complaint/commendation portal with tracking numbers and status updates to complainants. Publish timelines to disposition...

- **Community Commanders & Problem-Solving Plans**

Assign lieutenants as "community commanders" over defined beats with monthly office hours. Each beat maintains a problem-solving plan co-authored with residents (lighting, abatement, traffic safety). Scorecards show...

- **Deputy Training: De-Escalation & Duty to Intervene**

Mandate scenario-based de-escalation, duty-to-intervene, and trauma-informed interviewing. Tie training completion to promotion eligibility. Quarterly skill refreshers use VR/simulator labs and peer coaching. Publish...

- **Jail Reentry & Recidivism Reduction**

Create a reentry pipeline starting at intake: ID restoration, medication continuity, MAT for OUD, GED/CTE classes, and job placement partnerships. Track 90-day and 1-year returns to custody and publish program...
